1. Curriculum Mapping Project	June – September 2010	Four Curriculum Consultants will undertake this work. AISSA staff will provide expert advice and support	Consultants work with 10 schools to map current curriculum against each of the 4 subjects and report on scope and sequence, gaps, overlaps, additional resources required (physical, teaching, human, etc) A common mapping tool will be used.
