INTRA-OPERATIVE COMPLICATIONS OF PROSTHETIC LARYNGOPLASTY

- Haemorrhage from deep in the surgical site- Hemorrhage usually stops or reduces significantly when the suture is tightened and tied. Therefore, the surgery should be hastened to accomplish tying of the suture as soon as possible
- Needle breakage
- Perforation of the laryngeal mucosa
- Prosthetic suture 'cut through' of either the cricoid cartilage or muscular process of the arytenoid cartilage
