

## **POST-OPERATIVE CARE, COMPLICATIONS AND PROGNOSIS FOR THIRD EYELID REMOVAL**

These animals do not require any specific postoperative management related to the surgery. One should examine the cow closely for other squamous cell carcinoma lesions and owners should observe the animal in the future for new lesions.

Complications following this procedure are minimal and the prognosis is generally good unless the tumour has affected deeper tissues such that complete resection is not possible. In this case enucleation or exenteration of the affected eye is advised.
