Grade Description of Lameness

- 0 Lameness is not perceptible under any circumstances.
- 1 Lameness is difficult to observe; not consistently apparent regardless of circumstances (i.e., weight carrying, circling, inclines, hard surface, etc.).
- 2 Lameness is difficult to observe at a walk or in trotting a straight line; consistently apparent under certain circumstances (i.e., weight carrying, circling, inclines, hard surface, etc.).
- 3 Lameness is consistently observable at a trot under all circumstances.
- 4 Obvious lameness: marked nodding, hitching, or shortened stride.
- 5 Minimal weight-bearing in motion and/or at rest; inability to move.
