Toxic dose of lidocaine in cattle: 10mg/kg

Volume calculation = 
$$\frac{dose * weight}{concentraion}$$

For a cow estimated to be 500 kg,

Toxic volume of 2% lidocaine = 
$$\frac{10*500}{20}$$
 = 250  $ml$ 

Maximum volume for this cow =  $\frac{1}{2}$  \* toxic volume = 150 ml
