## - Solutions:

The linear equations usually have one solution (and of course only one solution). They are named compatible equations.

But sometimes, they have no solution. They are named noncompatible equations.

And you can find too identities (and not equations), because what we have on the left-hand side of the equal sign is no different to what we have on the right-hand side. This means that the variable can take any value. An identity has infinite solutions.
