# Prevention of Equine Lameness

### ➤ Provide proper hoof care

- Clean hooves daily to remove manure and/or mud.
- Check shoes daily, noting any changes, odd odor or discharge.

### ➤ Leg protection

• Prevents the animal from hitting limbs against surfaces

#### ➤ Ferrier visits

- Hooves should be trimmed regularly.
- New shoes are required every 6-8 weeks.

### ➤ Check stall flooring

- Ensure no objects are on the floor that can potentially stab/ damage the hooves.
- o Avoid hard surfaces for long periods of time.

## ➤ Cold therapy

• Used on limbs after strenuous work to reduce inflammation.
