## **Advantages & Disadvantages of Hoof Trimming**

## **Advantages**

- 1. Prevent foot rot and lameness
- 2. Prevent overgrowth of the hoof.
- 3. Decrease susceptibility to harboring of bacteria.
- 4. Maintain hoof health.
- 5. Prevent mobility issues.
- 6. Removing dead/ diseased horn and other tissue to promote growth of new horn.
- 7. Improvement on animal welfare.

## **Disadvantages**

- 1. Poor trimming procedure can potentially lead to lameness.
- 2. Excessive removal of the outer wall of the hoof which can result in white line disease.
- 3. Excessive trimming of the heel of the inner claw or rear can cause the soles to be worn if the animal is on concrete.
- 4. Can inflict pain/ discomfort to the animal if not properly restrained.
