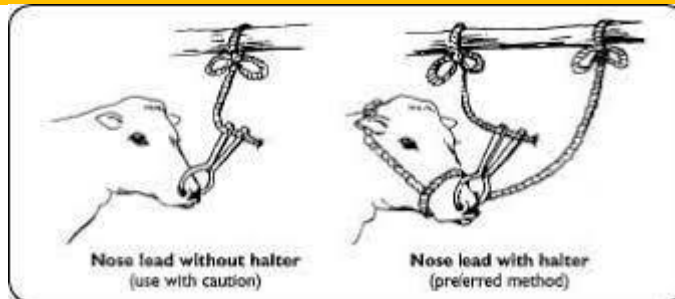

Halter and lead rope



- Used to guide animals to areas for physical exam
- Tying to stalls using a simple quick-release slip knot also allows good head restraint
- Can provide good head restraint from pre to post operation
- Inexpensive and effective

Nose pinch



- Can also be done using your thumb and middle finger to apply pressure to nasal septum
- Done to distract the animal from other operations ongoing, and keep the head restrained forward
- Best for preoperative clinical exam (may not have much effect intra-operatively)
- Inexpensive

Head table



- Greatly limits mobility of the head
- Easy to apply and manoeuvre
- Expensive (may not find local farms with such equipment)

Head clamp and/or head gate



- Greatly limits mobility of the head
- Easy to apply and manoeuvre
- Expensive (may not find local farms with such equipment)
